## Part 3: Claimant Application & Email to Solicitor

## Instructions

Obtain a section *61(1) form – Claimant Application* – by visiting the appropriate website <a href="https://www.fedcourt.gov.au/forms-and-fees/forms/native-title-regulations">https://www.fedcourt.gov.au/forms-and-fees/forms/native-title-regulations</a>

Download the entire form and complete each section. You should have received all the information necessary to complete this application form. Ensure the form is signed.

You will also need to obtain a *form 59 affidavit*, to be included with your Claimant application. Remember, the affidavit should be from your client's perspective as you are helping them to draft it.

Both the Claimant Application form and affidavit must be completed in full. Do not leave any parts blank.

Once the form and affidavit are complete you will need to present them to your principal solicitor for reviewing and signing and then lodge them with the appropriate court. To do this, draft an email (using the **Email to Solicitor Template** provided) that includes the following:

- The subject of your email should include the correct court name; and
- References to the Claimant Application, affidavit and any supporting documents as attachments.
